Summit Achievement, located on the boundary of the White Mountain National Forest, is a state-licensed outdoor and academic program for adolescents who are experiencing problems at home or at school. The program utilizes a combination of wilderness adventure, therapeutic, and academic programming in a structured environment. Summit has year-round employment opportunities available.

Responsibilities:

Work directly with students in all components of the program by providing guidance, counseling and instruction. Participate in weekly expeditions and academic elements as a member of a three-person team while performing specific duties as either a Logistician, Medic, or Team Leader. Staff schedule is a week on and week off.

Qualifications:

One year of previous experience working with adolescents preferred. Undergraduate degree recommended. Current First Aid and CPR required; Wilderness First Responder, Wilderness EMT, or equivalent is recommended. Must be at least twenty-one years of age. Applicants with education or interest in social work, experiential education, outdoor recreation, psychology or related fields are encouraged to apply.
